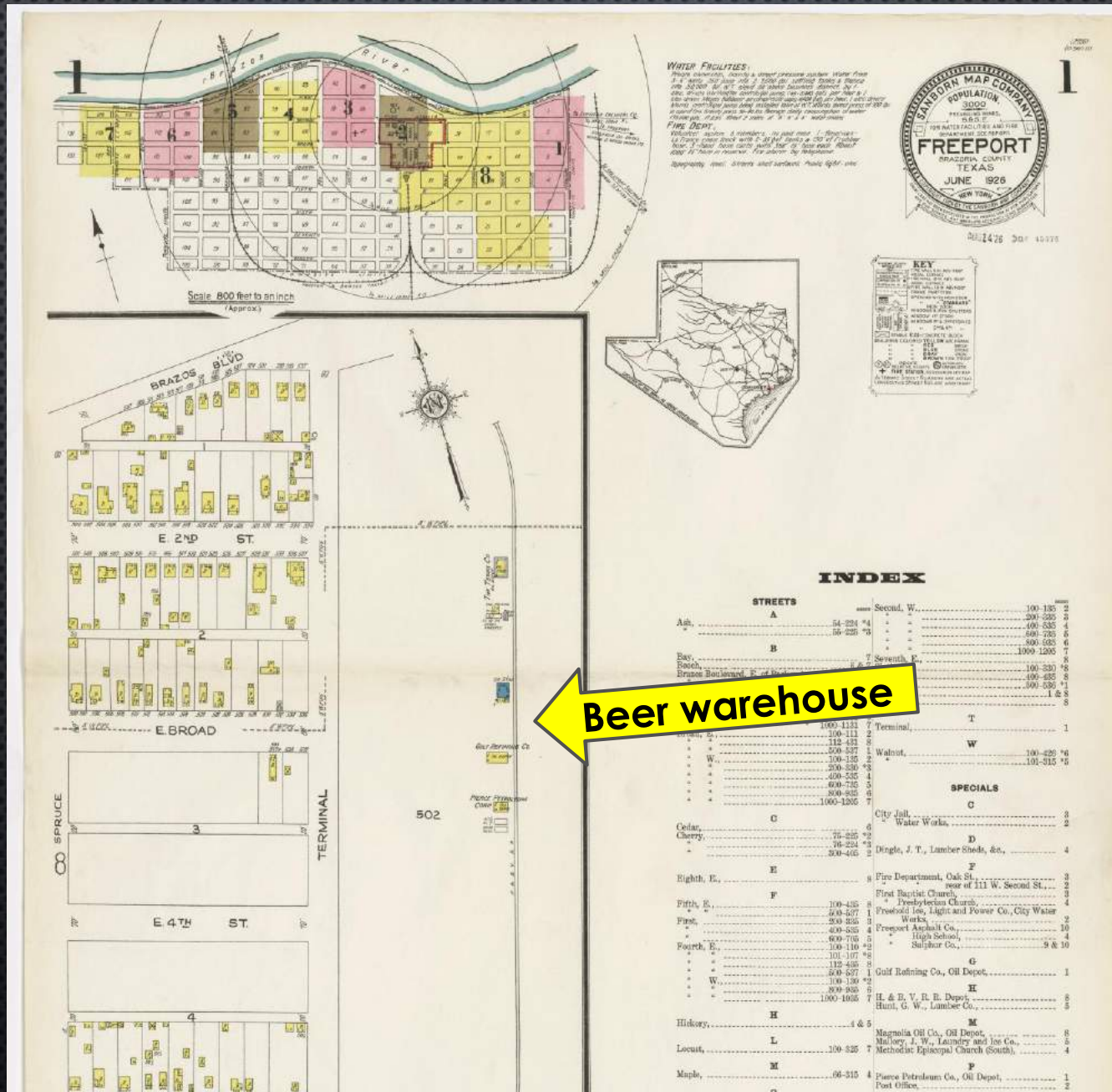

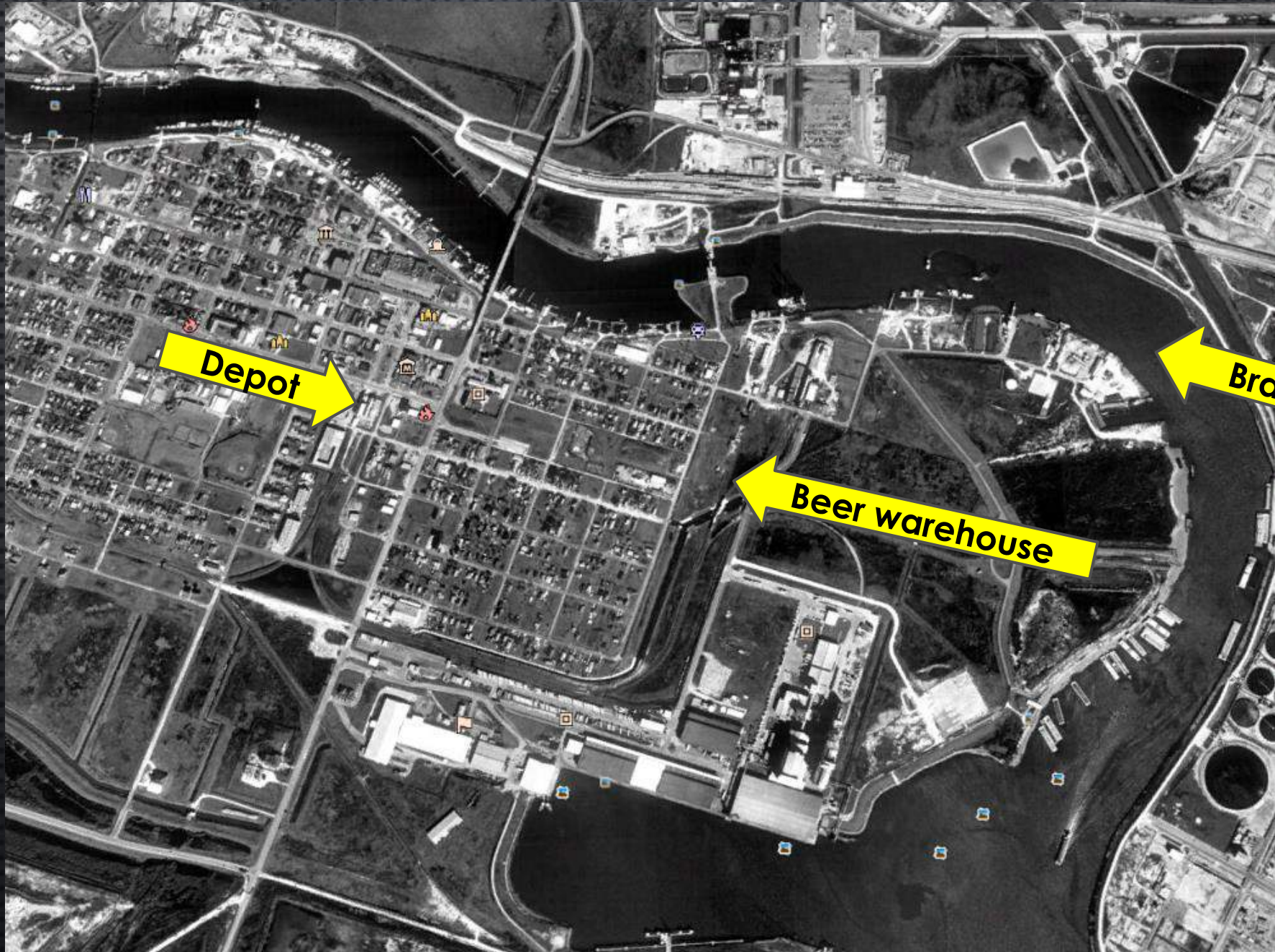

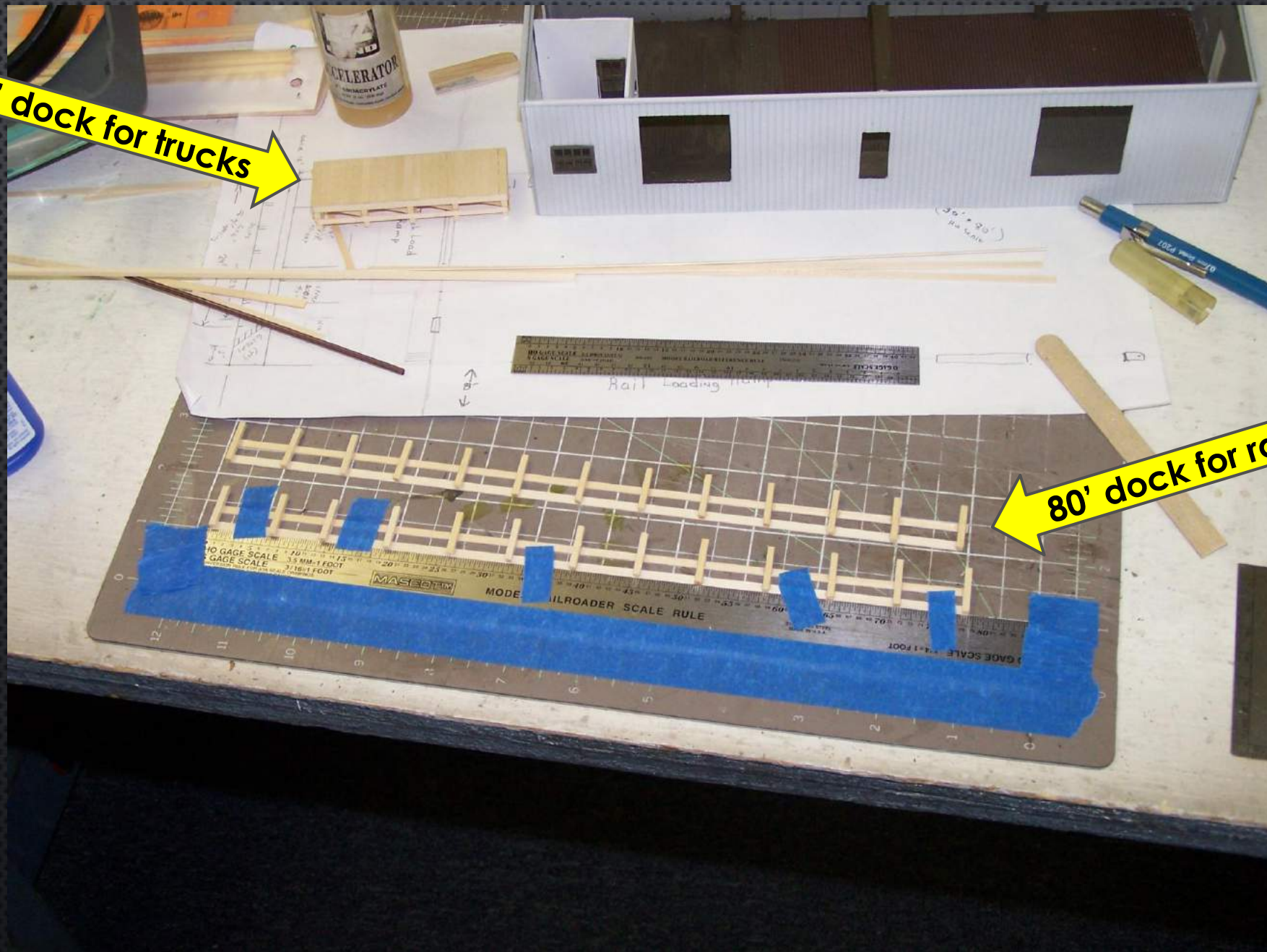

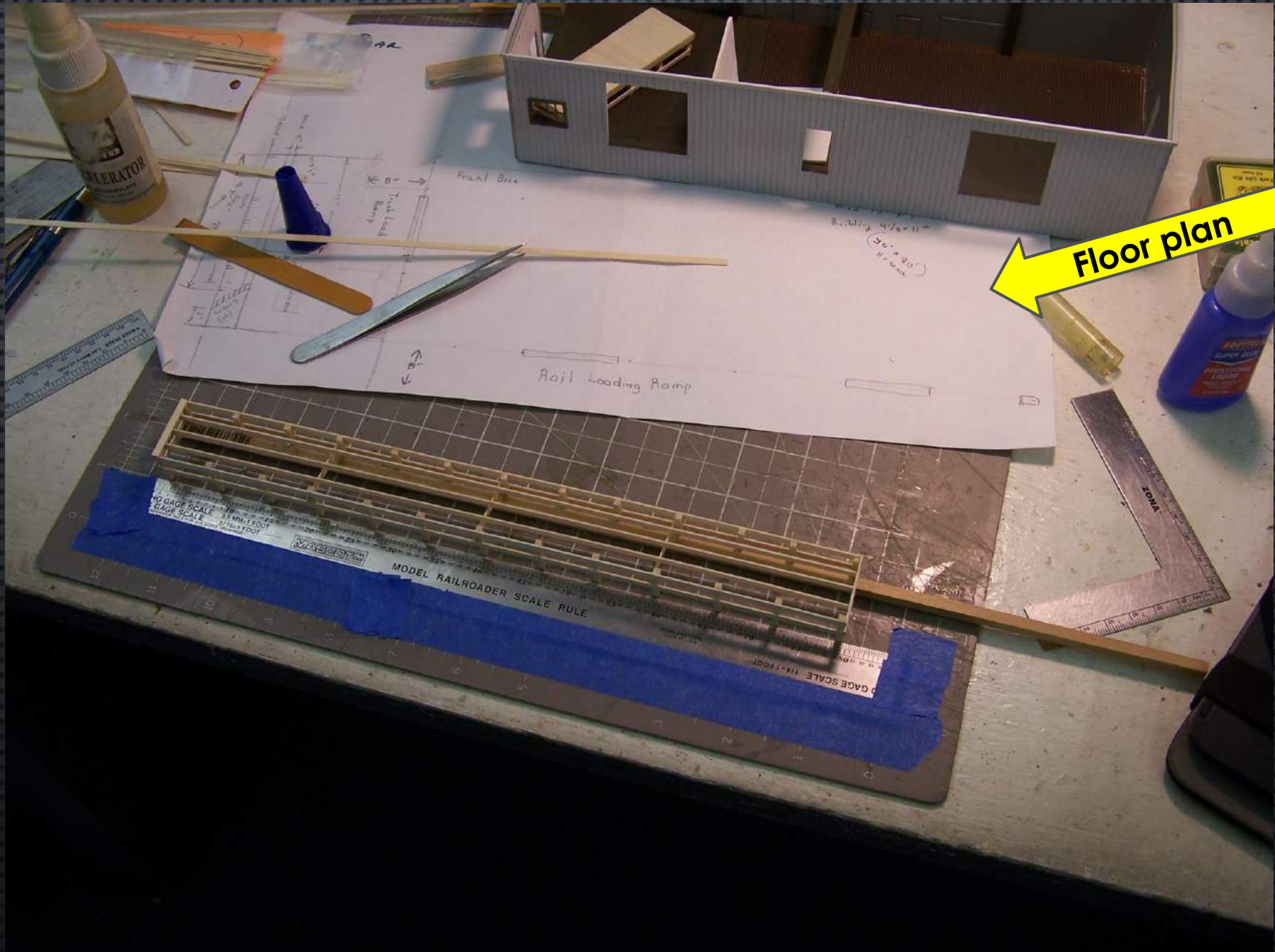
20' dock for trucks

Scratch built 30x80' steel warehouse with rail freight platform and a truck loading platform.

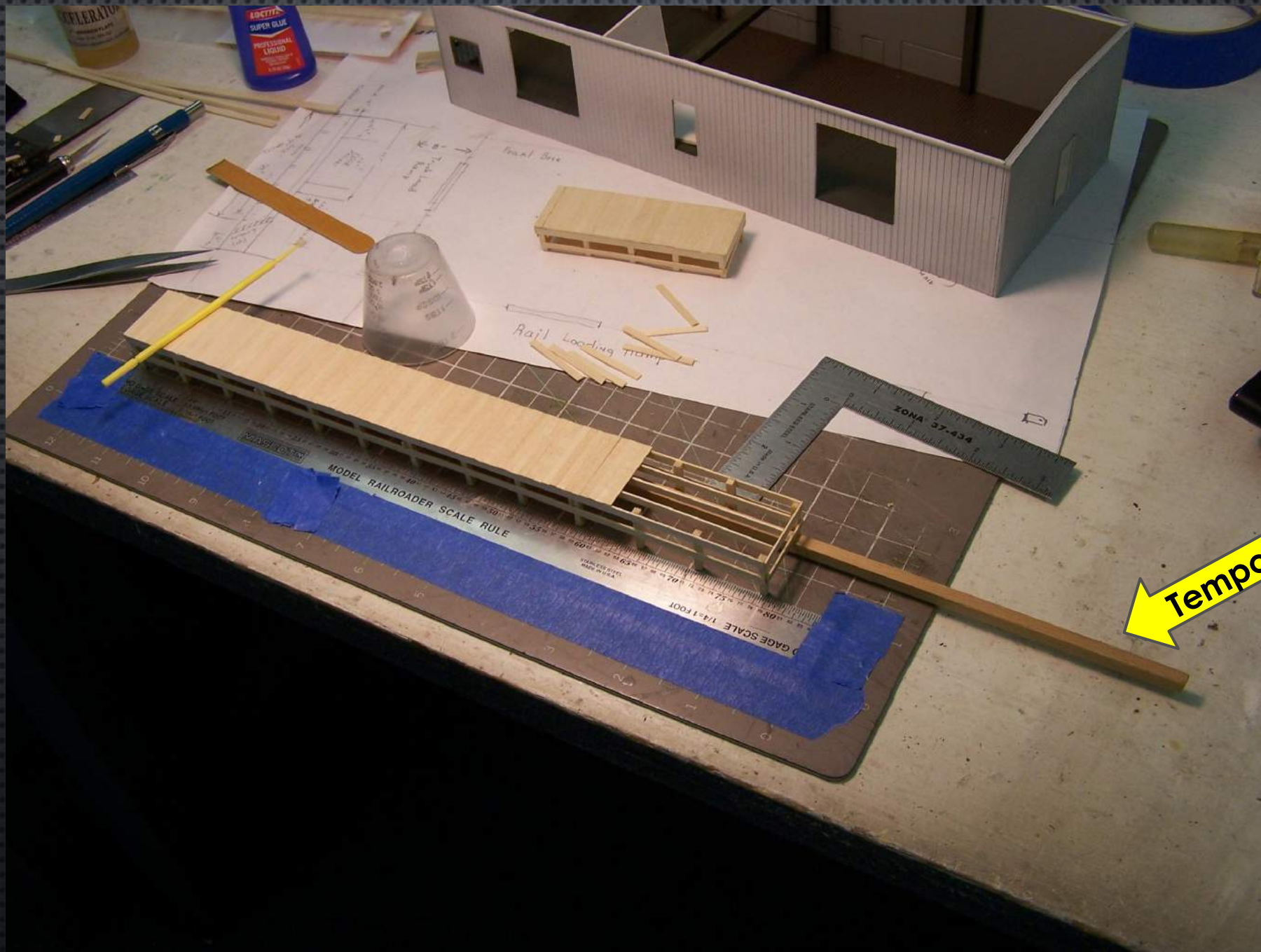
80' x 8'

Temporary brace

Beginning of foundation for scene using sand; start with the building foot print.

Want this area to be flat for even contact between building and ground.



Once the glue has dried (24 hours) and the forms removed, the surface is sanded smooth.



Next is the area under the platforms, and around the rear and sides of the building.



This additional area is sanded smooth after the glue dried (24 hours).

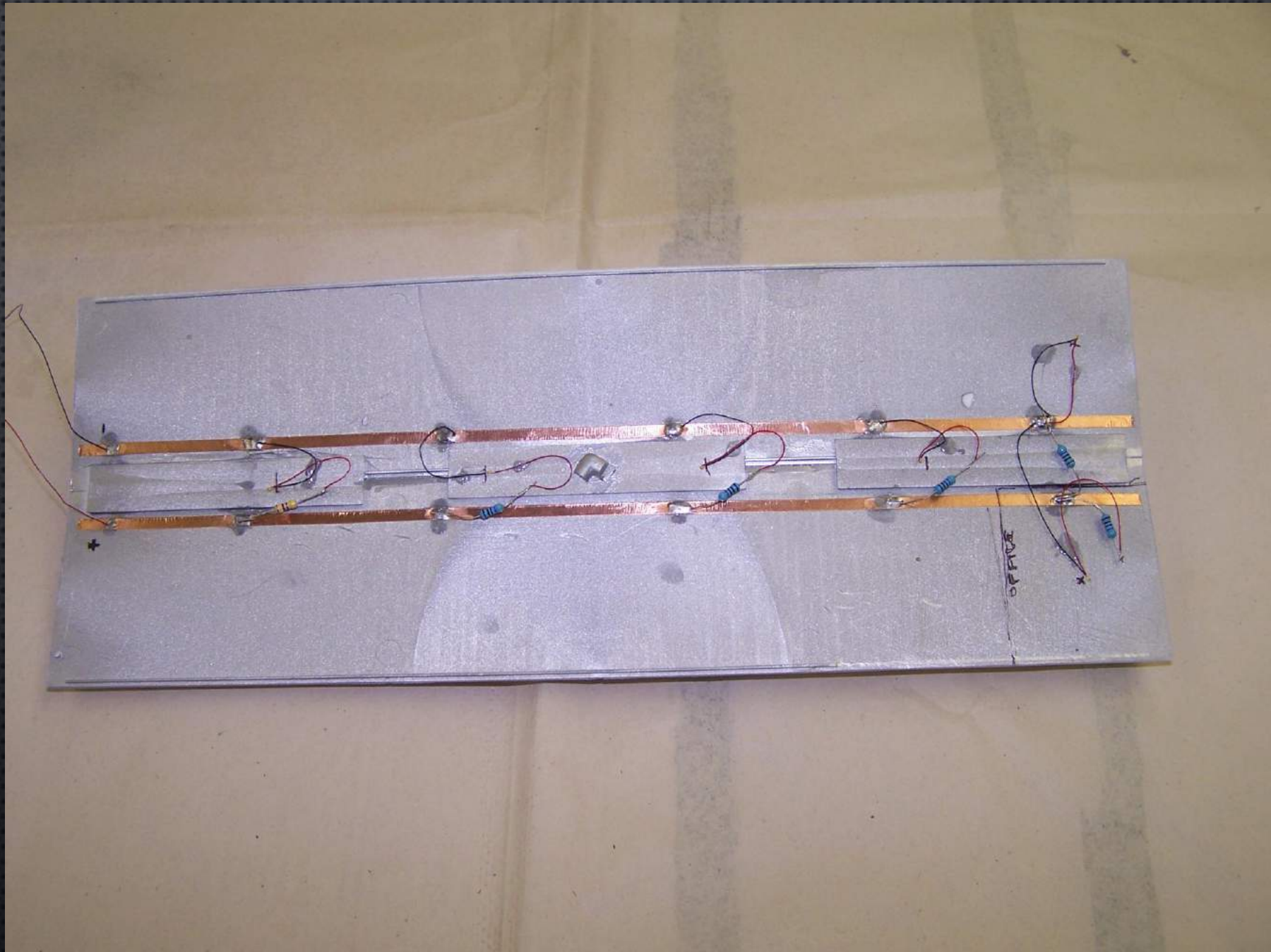

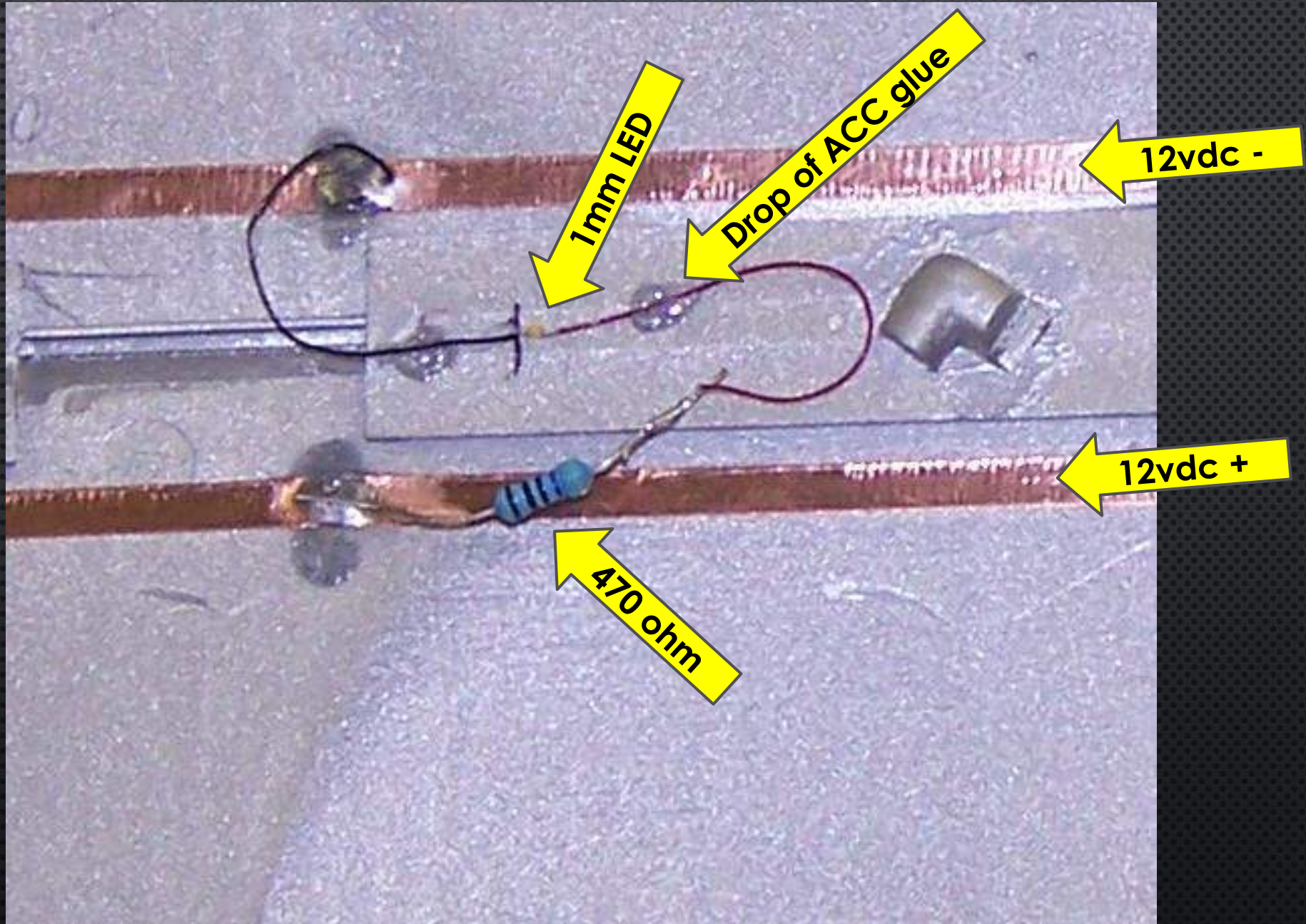


LED lights have been added to the underside of the room to illuminate the office and storage areas.

Note the use of ribbon bus wire.

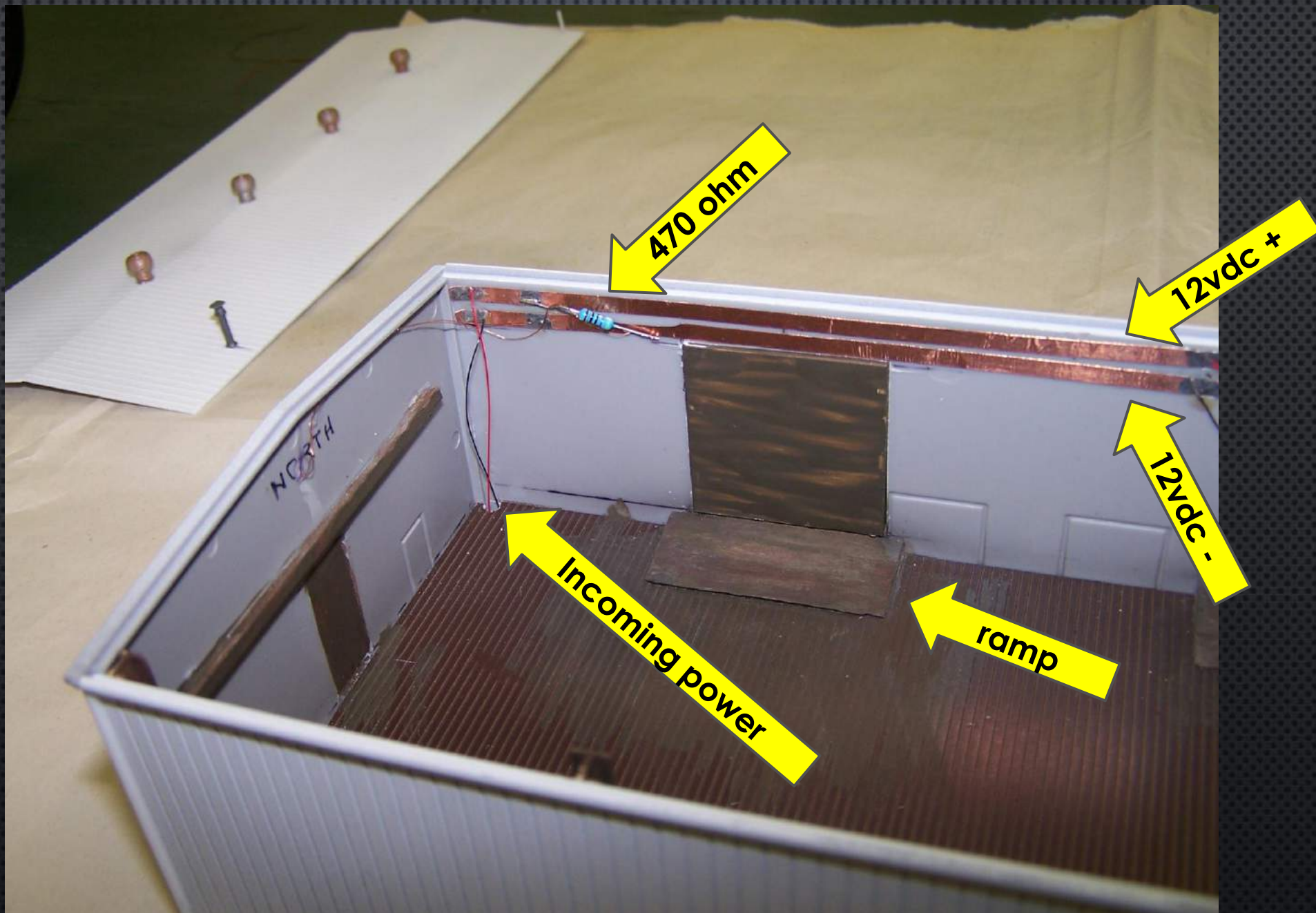


Typical

Details of wiring to LED lights over entry doors.

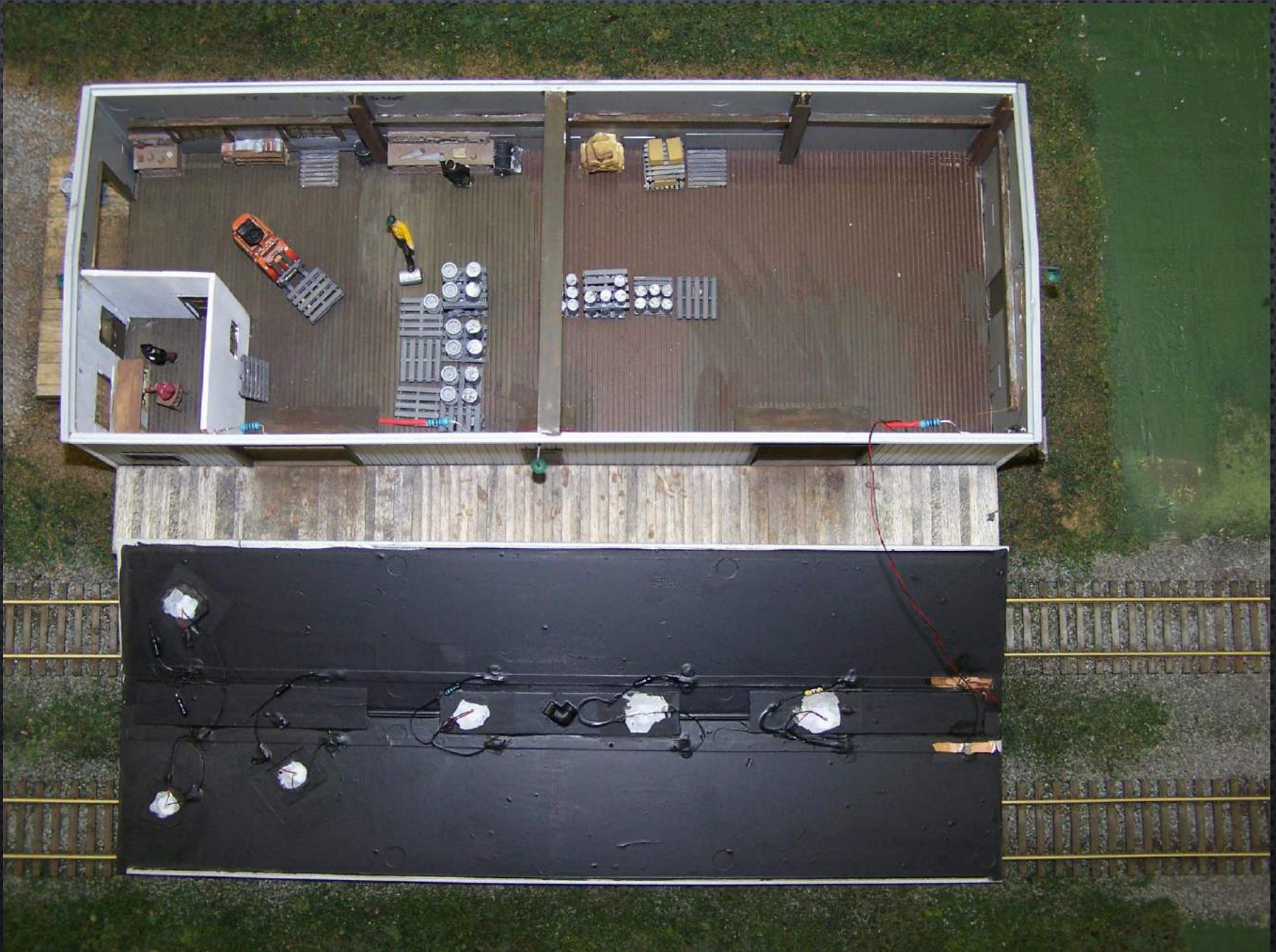
Note the rail platform is 2' higher than the building floor, hence the ramp.
